- 68B 'OL    -late 1930 (folding irons over the doors have a thumb lock, and has an adjustable front seat)
- 68B '1      -early 1931 (straight windshield post)
- 68C        -Late 1931 (slant windshield post)
- ASSOC     -no Cabriolet
